[40 items, out of at least 112, copied: we find no trace of the remainder, or of the parent MS] however, several concordances with the Leyden MS (GB-NTu) lead to a supposition that more Leyden tunes might be found in the complete Blackie MS!

Nearly all items lack rhythm signs - as do many items in the Leyden MS.
